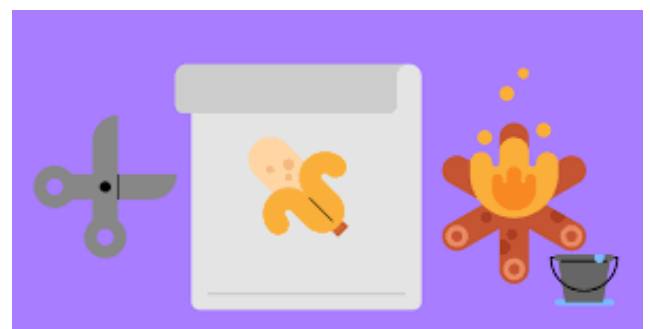

 A – Air Spotter = Air Spotter Activity Badge  
 B – First Aid = Emergency Aid Staged Activity Badge  
 C – Civil Defence = Community Impact or Communicator  
 D – Handyman = Builder or DIY Activity Badges  
 E – Fire Fighter = Fire Safety Activity Badge  
 F – Interpreter = International or Communicator  
 G – Guide or Pathfinder = Local Knowledge or Navigator  
 H – Wirelssman = Communicator Activity Badge  
 I – Rabbit Farmer = Farming Activity Badge
