

Cubs Faith Activity Badge



Activities to support your Cub pack achieve their faith activity badge – adapt the activities as you wish.

These activities can be led by Leaders or why not get your Young Leaders stuck in too!

























1 - Reflection

You will need access to a range of prayers or readings.

Either at your group meeting or as a home challenge, ask your Cub pack to select a prayer or reading that they enjoy and get them to explain why. This could be done in small groups or as a whole.

2 – Explore a place of worship

You will need paper, pencils and clipboards.

Explore the inside and/or outside of your chosen place of worship. Write down 5 things you can see, 4 things you can feel, 3 things you can hear, 2 things you can smell and 1 thing you can taste. *For taste, you could try some traditional food that that is typically eaten at the place of worship.











3 – Question Time

You will need paper and pencils. Optional: devices connected to the internet or invite someone from your chosen place of worship

In groups or as a Cub pack, come up with some questions you would like to find out about your chosen faith or religion. You could find out the answers to your questions using either devices or speaking to someone for your chosen faith or religion such as your local vicar.

5 – Object Discovery

You will need a range of religious/sacred objects or contact with someone from a local place of worship.

Find out about some of the religious/sacred objects used within a particular religion. You could do this by inviting someone such as your local vicar to bring along some objects or you could take a trip their place of worship.

6 – Festival Time

As a Cub pack, select a religious festival and explore what is and why people celebrate it.

- a) Do a food tasting evening where your pack tries some of the traditional food eaten at your chosen festival.
- b) Design your own outfits in the style of the festival you are exploring.
- c) Listen to some traditional music from your chosen festival.







7 – Story Time

You will need a religious or cultural story and acting props.

Read a religious or cultural story to your Cubs that links to the place of worship you have been exploring. Your Cubs could make some props beforehand (be as adventurous as you like). Act out the story as a Cub pack or in small groups. Some children could be the narrator and others could do the acting.
