# Top Awards 2022-23

The 2023 Top Awards Celebration took place at St. George's Theatre on 10 September and followed the theme of "The Oscars".

The achievement of Top Awards uplifted on the previous year by 18%, which is a great reflection of the high level of programme delivery across East Norfolk District.

Bronze Award was achieved by 28 Beaver Scouts (28% of the age group) Silver Award was achieved by 52 Cub Scouts (30% of the age group) Gold Award was achieved by 16 Scouts (12% of the age group) 1 Platinum and 1 Diamond Award were achieved by Explorers.

The event also celebrated the achievements of twelve adults who were recognised by the Chief Scout for their outstanding service to Scouting.

One of our Youth Leads, Jake was presented with his Scout of the World Award, the first to be achieved in the County of Norfolk – Fantastic!
