Literacy is incredibly important at this age and the story sets up the theme for the meeting.

The story in each meeting plan is a suggestion and can be changed for another story that you feel better sets up the theme of the meeting.

The use of picture books is great as the young people can follow the story along with the storyteller.

Safety alerts

Make sure that all story books used are age appropriate.

Equipment

A focus point to gather around is helpful, and then the young people know it is story time.

A toy campfire works well placed in the centre of the sitting circle.

Before you begin

Make sure that everyone is sitting comfortably.

Stop the story

If the young people start to lose interest in the story and complete it at the end of the session or at another meeting.

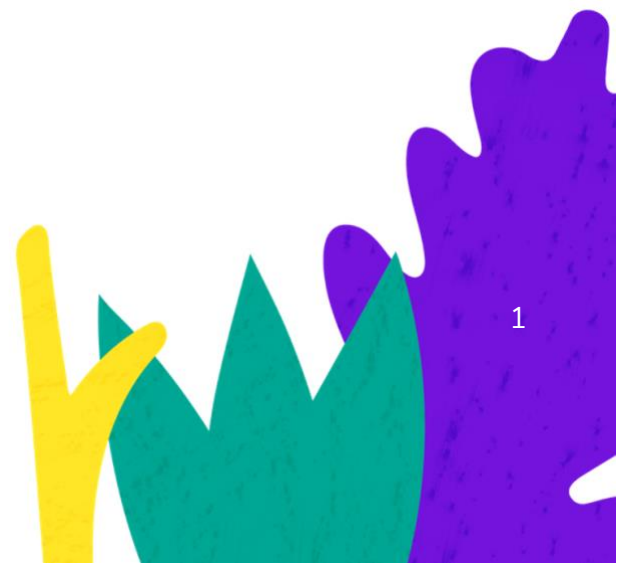
