Parent or Carer Framework...

All Scout Groups and Explorer Units have a duty to make reasonable adjustments to support the participation of young people with special needs. Developing a positive relationship and working in partnership with parents or carers, is key to supporting the successful inclusion of young people with additional needs in Scouting.

When a young person with additional needs or disabilities is joining Scouting, we advise an initial meeting with the parent or carer. This will enable you to identify the young person's individual needs and plan any support needed to enable them to access Scouting. The conversation should involve the leader, parent or carer and, if appropriate, the young person themselves.
