The group was registered in 1929 by group Scoutmaster Charles Arthur Grant with 7 Wolf Cubs, and 16 Scouts, meeting in the Wesleyan School Rooms, Gorleston, and closed in 1933.

The group re-opened in 1949 under J. W. Wright and relocated to Shrublands Youth and Adult Centre in 1955 under Scoutmaster B. A. Clarke.

In 1969 10th Gt. Yarmouth amalgamated with 19th Gt. Yarmouth to form the 1st Gorleston group.
