Senior Scouts and Rover Crews

An older section was introduced in 1917 on Baden Powell's suggestion to start Senior Scouts.

The 1st Great Yarmouth Senior Scout patrol was launched and W. H. Back was the leader.

In 1918 the Rover section was started.

The 5th Great Yarmouth Rover Crew met at the Lady Haven Public House in Cobholm, and the 8th Great Yarmouth Rover Crew met on a boat on Breydon Water.
