Local Trophies

Over the years there have been a variety of local trophies to use for competitions to develop "Skills for Life".

Many of the trophies have been dedicated in memory of the Scouters who inspired the young people and fellow leaders.

Some of the early trophies include: The Ambulance Trophy, a statue for Scouts gifted by Arthur S. Hewitt, which was later used for Swimming.

The Troop Efficiency Trophy, a cup gifted by Cmdr. Addison-Williamson, which was later re-purposed as a trophy for Cub Fishing.

The Nightowl Cup, a cup for Scouts dedicated in memory of Brian Dixon.

The Wiltshire Trophy, a shield for Cubs gifted by the Wiltshire Family
